This report is a sincere and humble attempt to showcase our progress in terms of achievements and activities during the session.

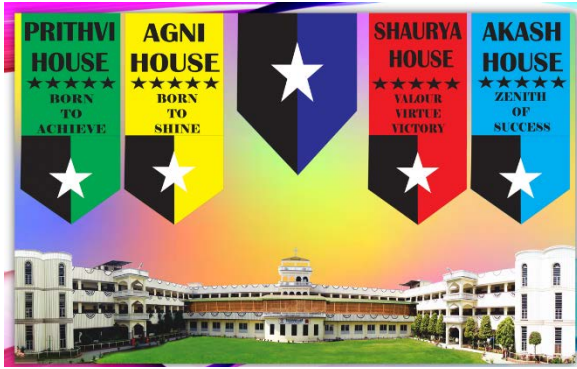
The Academic prowess were proved again with the glorifying **success in the Board Examinations wherein the school achieved a 100% result.**

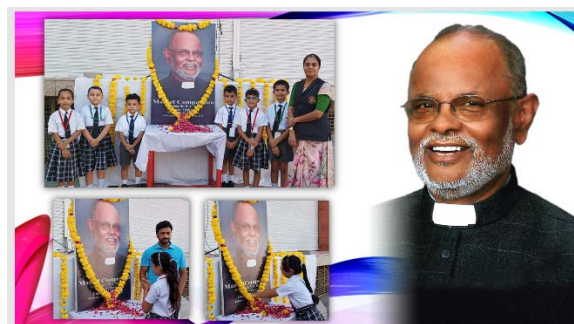

Picnics were organized for the Junior as well as senior most classes of the school.



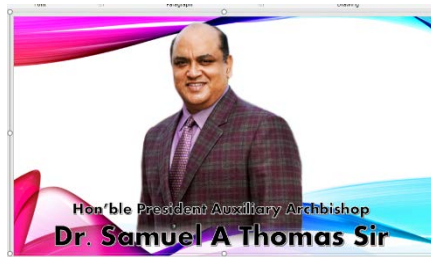
Our tiny toddlers in 'Little Champs' made their presence felt the entire year, be it academic, cultural or sports activities.
